WHAT IS THIS MINISTRY?

Eucharistic Adoration is a ministry of prayer and a posture of love, the placing of oneself in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, whether reposed inside the tabernacle, or exposed inside a special display vessel called a monstrance. Adoration allows for a personal encounter with Jesus Christ, who is truly and physically present in a special way in the Eucharistic liturgy and in the Eucharistic species.

People who want to experience the peace and quiet of praying before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.
