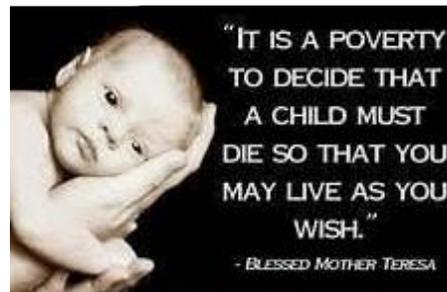
### Today's Reflection

### Today's Reflection
