






**Jesus Prays in the Garden of Olives**

counsel of the wicked,


nor go the way of sinners

in your presence forever.




Jesus is

Pilate







**All:** O God, whom I praise,

with Thorns**






**All:**

the reach of my foes.


Deliver me from the

for in you I trust.


Show me the path I should walk,

and in pain;


let your saving help

## Jesus is Crucified








**All:**

of the shadow of death,


I will fear no evil,

Jesus Promises to Share His Reign with the Good Thief








**All:**

abounding in mercy.


For as the heavens tower  
over the earth,


so his mercy towers over

# Jesus' Mother and His Disciple Stand by His Cross






**All:**

you are my only good.


I keep the Lord

**Jesus Dies on the Cross**








**All:**

for help,



from my cries of anguish?
