

**Come To The Water ACC Pastoral Council Meeting  
Held at Church of the Immaculate Conception, Osakis  
March 15, 2022 – 6:30 p.m.**

The meeting opened with prayer.

Pastors' Perspective

- Earlier today, Father Dave shared via email a summary of the survey done last month on what a bulletin should look like and what should be included in it. He noted that Molly is reviewing that information and getting ideas for the joint bulletin. There was discussion on a Ministry Pro software program that could be used for scheduling of ministry volunteers; the volunteer would get a weekly text reminder and then get another text the day before their assignment.
- Father Matthew asked for discussion on where to locate the pastor's office space; how to handle the assignment of priests for weekend masses; how often to rotate assignments (weekly, monthly, etc.). Father Matthew said there will not be any changes in the current mass times at Belle River, Osakis or Alexandria.

Minutes of the Last Meeting

- Randy noted that we need to add to the February meeting minutes that St. Mary's School is exploring the idea of adding preschool classes, as well as adding 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade classes.

Todd Wentworth's News

- Todd talked about attending Monsignor McCread's Stewardship Conference in Wichita, Kansas last summer. He encouraged pastoral council members to consider attending. The conference is more like a retreat; it focuses on hospitality, formation, prayer and service. The next conference will be held August 10-11, 2022 in Wichita. He noted that often people from neighboring parishes attend and that car pools could be set up to go as a group.
- Todd said after some design work with architects, they have found that a remodeling project in the school kitchen is rather complex and expensive. With the renewed interest in expanding the school to include preschool and grades 7 and 8, it has been decided to find temporary solutions for the food service needs and then work on a master campus plan. A school expansion subcommittee will be touring other Catholic schools this spring.
- General Administrative Report – Todd has started the annual planning process.
- A Lenten Mission with Vallimar Jansen is planned for March 27-29, 6:30-8:00 p.m. each evening at St. Mary's Church. No reservations are required. Todd noted that some assistance is needed in that Vallimar does not drive, so he handed out a schedule of her visit that indicated where volunteers are needed to pick Vallimar up from the airport & hotel, and to bring her back to the hotel & airport.
