 - Stewardship is a journey, starting small and building upon

- SMS has a Service Month in October perfect timing to tie-in with stewardship.
- Testimonials can be powerful, sharing those Holy Moments.
- Encourage various ministries to be more intentional taking pictures of their ministries in action and send to Kathy B.
- This summer, building a display of Service & Stewardship that can be updated during the year:
 - Rotate highlighting ministries to build familiarity
 - Laurie Bienias would be an excellent resource
 - Keep it organic and see where it goes goal is to have visual reminders of stewardship to build and then maintain momentum outside of Annual Renewal – the Holy Spirit can move people at different times
 - o There was a lot of excitement at this idea
- Coffee and Rolls always an opportunity to share for the ministries providing - Slideshow, handouts, etc.
- "Come and See" idea discussed in April's Meeting
- Focus on bridging the School / Parish gap
- Focus on what can families do? Kids Tithing, Family Adoration, build shrines in their homes – a dedicated prayer space, set aside. Theme of Acts of Service are requirements for families.
