Business Admin Update

Come to the Water ACC – We have posted the opening for the new **Director of Faith Formation (DFF)**. This will be a full-time position and will strategically oversee the faith formation programs at all 3 parishes. This is a goal from our 2018 ACC strategic plan. Please spread the word to help us hire the right person for our ACC. As of early winter, Leah Johnsrud has taken over as our new **Wedding Coordinator**. Jordyn Cantalope moved on to focus on her primary job. She did amazing work establishing systems and building communication channels for wedding coordination in our ACC. We greatly appreciate Jordyn for sharing her talents in this ministry! Other **Human Resource Stuff**: I am finalizing a revised Employee Handbook. With help from the diocese and an arrangement with their employment legal expert, we should have a well-written handbook for our employees when it is completed. The 2023 MN legislative session impacted our parishes with their significant law changes, specifically certain school employees eligible for unemployment benefits over the summer and the Earned Sick and Safe Time. As of January 1, we have made the necessary changes. Looking ahead to budget time, per 5 different national surveys, overall pay increases for 2024 are projected to be around 4.0%. As a service organization, with over 70% of our budget going to compensation and benefits, the next budget cycle may be challenging.

ST. MARY'S (STM) We have hired our new **Pastoral Care Coordinator (PCC)**. Welcome Patty Marriott to the team. Patty's primary role is to be the connection between parish volunteers and the homebound and



those in assisted living facilities. She will coordinate the main outreach from our parish to those who are unable to be physically with us. She is part-time working only 10-15 hours per week. We no longer have a parish nurse. Factors in the change include the difficulty in finding a qualified person to take on the big responsibility, finances, and the fact that the parish nurse position is generally fading away across the country. A new partnership between the Diocese of St. Cloud and SJU/CSB will allow for some educational resources to help support Patty and her volunteers. Our overall employee **headcount** is now at 38 full-time employees, 9 regular part-time employees, & several temporary part-time (i.e. substitutes, accompanists). For 2023, we filed 67 W-2s. We do provide work for a fair number of people.

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION (ICC)

Near the end of 2023, ICC received a very generous anonymous donation in excess of \$300,000. This is a great blessing which will allow us to renew various physical and spiritual components of our church. Stewardship is alive and well in our parish community.

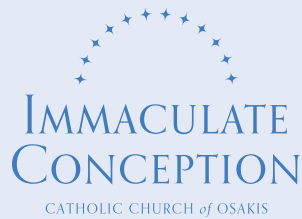

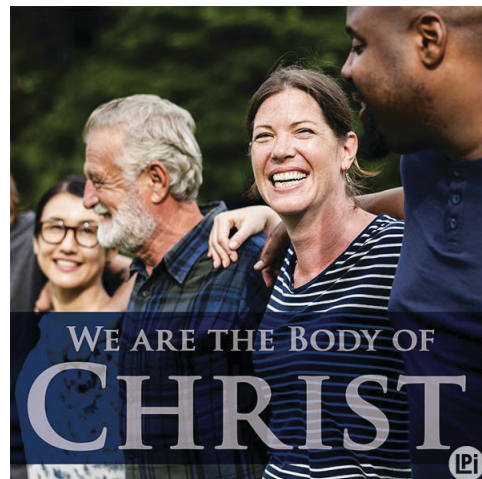
