Dear brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

Greetings from Rome! I have said goodbye to the pilgrimage tour group and am now starting my sabbatical program. I am living with a group of 24 priests from the US, Canada, Ireland, and Australia in a house just uphill from the Vatican.

Our pilgrimage was beautiful and uplifting. We visited the major churches of Rome, walked through the Holy Doors, attended an audience with Pope Francis, and saw a great deal of relics and art, from the Cross of Jesus to the “Pieta” of Michelangelo. Visiting Rome makes much of the history and presence of the Church come to life in very concrete detail.



Now I am settling in to a rhythm of study and reflection, sharing the joys and struggles of ministry with this group of veteran priests. Though I am the youngest of the group, I am not the most junior by ordination, as two of the brother priests have been ordained only ten years to my fourteen. All have shared some of their hopes for our time together, and I look forward to learning from them, traveling with them on the weekends, and immersing ourselves in the rich history of Europe that is only a train ride away from our house.

I continue to celebrate Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours for you and your intentions each day, visiting the shrines of the saints and asking their intercession. It is a great blessing for me, and I look forward to sharing stories and pictures with you when I return. I hope to send updates like this every few weeks until I see you again in April.



Please continue to pray for me as I do for you.

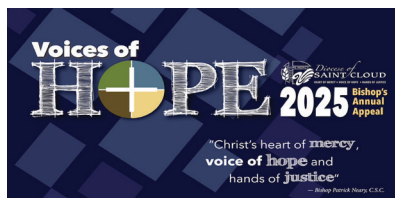

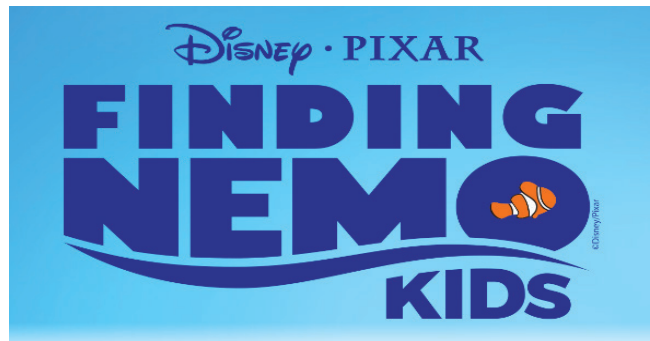
