COME TO THE WATER (ACC)

A week ago Fr. Bob shared in his homily about prepping for Lent, specifically maybe working on being a little bit more compassionate. This theme fits well with our ACC core values; Mutual Respect & Trust, Integrity, Community, Justice, & Compassion & Kindness. In order to live with more compassion & kindness, we strive to show unconditional love, appreciate each other's gifts and efforts, work with community organizations to support individuals in need, see first to understand (much like Jesus did on the Road to Emmaus), and respond with kindness in all situations, conflict and conversations.

Learning to show a little more compassion also fits well with the 5 guiding principles of our journey to All Things New. Missionary Discipleship, Sacramental Life, Engaging the Laity, Listening as a Way of Being Church, and Prudent Stewardship will guide us as we formulate a plan to do our part to become a more dynamic & re-energized diocese. We have 12 individuals comprising our All Things New Planning Committee for our ACC. Fr. Matt, Fr. Dan, Todd Wentworth (ACC Business Administrator), Joe Korkowski (ACC Communications Coordinator), Darcie Boogaard (ICC), Mike Helwig (ICC), Sharon Marthaler (ICC & SN), Francie Peterson (StM), Luke VanOverbeke (StM Director of Liturgy & Music), Josh Waltzing (StM), Tonya Beulke (SN), & Nate Hillmer (SN). I ask you to pray for our team and our diocese as we work through the process. I encourage you to stay educated on the process by spending some time on the webpage, <https://stcdio.org/all-things-new/> and paying attention to the

monthly Central MN Catholic magazine. The diocese updates their webpage regularly, so check in each month. As ACC staff we strive to provide opportunities for our parishioners to live as Missionary Disciples. One such opportunity coming up on April 25 is the Harvest Pack food packing event. We have set a goal to pack 75,000 meals, which will beat last year's mark. 100% of the meals we pack this year will be for food shelves in Minnesota, including Alexandria. The need for food in our communities is increasing, and we can help. As

part of this project, we must cover the cost of ingredients which only runs \$0.30 per meal. That is a super great value for a nutritious meal. That is also \$22,500! This will come from our regular sacrificial offerings and additional donations. We are also called to be Prudent Stewards, aren't we?

One final note regarding our crucifix at St. Mary's. The crucifix has been approved by our Corporate Board

(see inside bulletin) and the components have been ordered. We hope to have the installation complete by the end of summer. I previously noted that 100% of the crucifix would be covered by additional donations. With the selected cross and final installation costs now determined, we did run a little short by about \$1,600. So, we will use a part of our regular sacrificial offerings to cover this amount. All those who give regularly are contributing to the crucifix, not just a few. We are a parish community, after all.

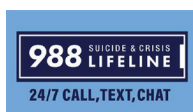

LENT 2025 – PENNY CHALLENGE

Each year during Lent the students and staff at St. Mary's participate in a unique penny collection competition that benefits a non-profit organization. The Penny Challenge allows classrooms to compete with one another to raise the most money in pennies. The class with the most pennies at the end of the challenge will win.

The event rules could end there, however there is an interesting twist to the challenge. As the pennies are being collected, a class may put silver coins or dollar bills into other classroom jars. The amount of silver and paper money placed in the jars will be subtracted from the total amount of pennies. If a class has a large lead on the amount of pennies they have collected, a couple dollars placed into their jar will allow other classes to catch up. After all the pennies are collected and the silver and paper money is subtracted from the jars, a classroom winner will be determined.

The Penny Challenge will begin on March 13, and will take place each Friday of Lent until April 11. After April 11, the coins will be counted

and the class with the most pennies, minus the silver and paper, will be the Penny Challenge winner!

This year's proceeds from the St. Mary's School Penny Challenge will be donated to Our Lady of Victory Catholic School in Fergus Falls. On January 14, 2025, there was a fire at Our Lady of Victory Catholic Church. As a result, their school suffered smoke damage. The classroom games, toys and books can't be cleaned and need to be replaced. Our donation will help teachers and students purchase those needed items.
