Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With both Pope Francis' health being in the news recently and the Diocese of St. Cloud going through the All Things New organizational plan, it's a good time to review how the Catholic Church is organized and governed. And further: Why do these things matter to me as an individual follower of Christ in central MN?

The Catholic Church is governed with a hierarchical structure. The pope is the top leader in this structure. This is both with regards to him being our spiritual leader and him being the administrator of material goods and the laws of the Church. Cardinals are selected by the pope to assist him in carrying out this governance. There are currently 225 cardinals. Cardinals serve in a vital role as they are the ones responsible for selecting the next pope. Bishops are selected to govern a specific region in the world. There are currently around 5,600 bishops in the Catholic Church. A bishop is given leadership of a diocese (sometimes in large metro areas he is given assistant bishops to help). There are currently over 2,900 dioceses in the Catholic Church. A diocese is also referred to as a "local church." Our diocese, the Diocese of St. Cloud, is led by Bishop Patrick Neary.

A bishop is tasked with providing for the spiritual care of a diocese as well as management of its physical assets. Every bishop has a tie directly to the pope, and this is due to the pope being the one who selects the bishop. Suitable candidates for bishop are submitted to the papal nuncio who, after investigation, submits three names to the pope. After his own review, the pope selects one as the next bishop. The pope also has the power to impose disciplinary measures on a bishop or even remove them from office if necessary.

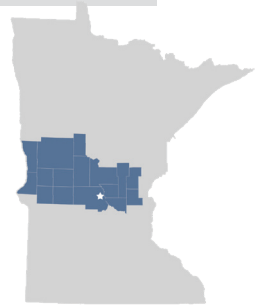
Within a diocese, parishes are formed to provide for the spiritual needs of those living in the region. Due to large numbers of Catholics, most bishops ordain priests to assist them in their ministry and then appoint pastors. A pastor is a priest who is appointed as the chief leader of a parish, in charge of both spiritual care and care of

physical assets. There are around 220,000 Catholic parishes in the world and over 407,000 priests. A bishop ordains diocesan priests specifically to assist him in his leadership and assigns them to a specific parish or ministry. Bishops also can impose disciplinary measures on a priest or even remove them from ministry. Thus, a priest participates in the ministry of the bishop and is bound to obedience and cooperation with him (he solemnly promises this at his ordination).

Why is this the model the Catholic Church uses? This can't be totally covered in this article, but it comes down to Jesus choosing the 12 apostles. The 12 apostles were automatically and naturally looked to for leadership in the early Church. The 12 apostles then chose others to assist them in their ministry. This occurred generation to generation. A bishop is thus a successor of the apostles, as each bishop (in theory, even if not historically recorded) can trace his ordination all the way back to one of the original 12. We believe as Catholics that this is the model or governance set up by Jesus through the Holy Spirit. Practically, this hierarchical model serves as a safeguard for the truths of the faith. Throughout the centuries, countless errors have been combated and the truth defended by bishops and popes. Jesus expressed His desire for us to be "one." (Jn 17:21) Hierarchical governance ensures the unity of the Catholic Church. The policies and practices issued from the pope and the Vatican are handed down through bishops. The bishop, through the help of his priests, then ensures they are implemented at the parish level.

Thus, the Catholic Church is able to function as one body, whether we live in Central MN or Africa. Striving to respect the leadership of our priests, bishops, and pope therefore is a way in which we can all contribute to the building up of God's church on earth.

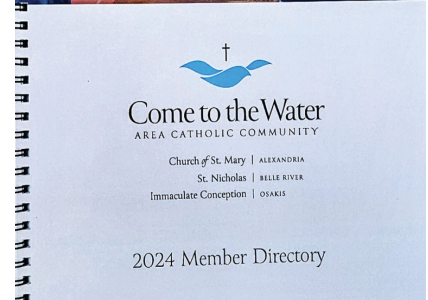
The Sponsor Couple program is a couple-to-couple ministry in which married couples mentor engaged couples to help prepare them for a Christian marriage.
