LUKE'S LATEST LITURGICS

Did you know? Each of our three parishes has a Liturgy Committee. What is a Liturgy Committee, what do they do, and why do they matter?

Glad you asked! Liturgy Committees are groups of parishioners appointed by the Pastor who advise the priests and parish staff on various topics regarding all things liturgical. They aren't necessarily "experts" in the sense that they know all the rubrics, history, or Catholic liturgical practices (that is one of my primary roles on the St. Mary's committee - being the "resource" person); but they are critical members because they provide us with pastoral guidance on how parishioners experience the Mass. They can see things from another perspective that might otherwise be missed.

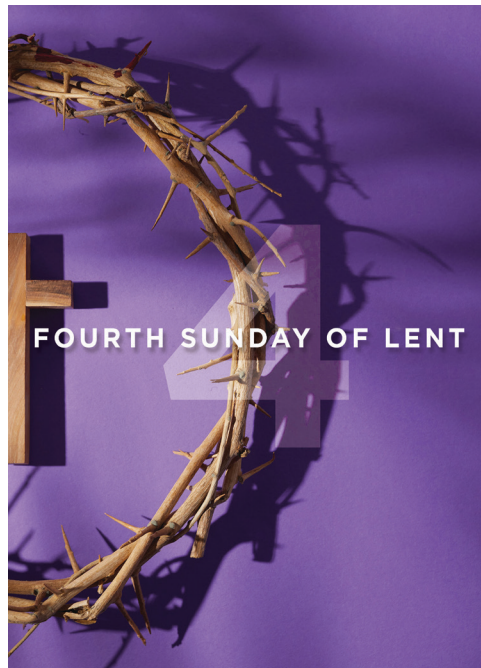
A Liturgy Committee does not promote their own preferences as most important, but are tasked with helping discern where the spirit is a-movin' for the good of all.

Liturgy Committees also help craft solutions or recommendations to tricky subjects. These can be difficult conversations to have, as each member brings

their own unique perspective to the conversation. Liturgy is very personal, and we all want our perspectives and experiences to be seen. Ironically, the healthiest committees are those where there is debate and disagreement. And still there is a responsibility to come to a consensus. Liturgy is never celebrated perfectly, but God always calls us to enter more deeply into the experience and consider where we may more authentically celebrate what he has given us. The

Liturgy isn't necessarily something we create on our own, but rather an expression of what God has revealed throughout human history in Jesus Christ. Another reason to trust God completely in God's infinite wisdom!

Holy Week is fast approaching. St. Mary's parishioners are highly encouraged to check out the sign-up table in the Commons Area. In addition to the usual ministries, there are opportunities to pass out palms on Palm Sunday, carry candles in at Tenebrae, and pass out tapers at the Easter Vigil. There are also a few slots still open for our Friday Stations of the Cross.

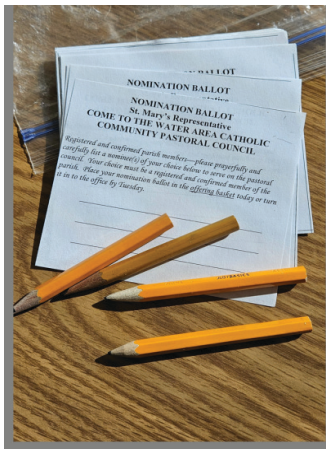

PASTORAL COUNCIL PROCESS

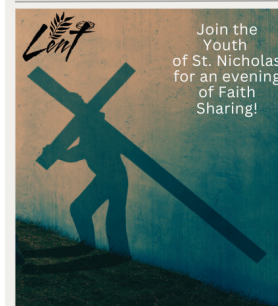

DID YOU KNOW?

When you contribute to the St. Mary's fish fry, you are actually helping a number of local causes that St. Mary's contributes to. In fact, 36% of our church's outreach budget goes to helping other organizations. Each year The Church of St Mary helps the Outreach Food Shelf, both with donated food, but also with a monetary donation. A few others that receive funds include West Central Communities Action, the YMCA Strong Kids program, and the Habitat for Humanity Build. One of the larger contributions will go to help pay for the Harvest Pack. That effort will feed 10's of thousands of people. We plan to pack 75,000 oatmeal "meals" on April 25. The total cost is \$22,500 for the ingredients. Many of those will go to the Outreach Food Shelf, and the rest will be distributed throughout other Minnesota food shelves. Enjoy the fish fries April 4 and 11 here at St Mary's, but know that your contributions multiply, just like Jesus did with the loaves and the fish.
